I wish to object to this enormous biodigester planned in open countryside. I appreciate that the huge amounts of chicken manure generated by the poultry industry needs managing but this is not the way to do it. If this is to be built it should be on an industrial site with access to a good road network.

In its proposed position in open countryside it will generate too much traffic which in itself will cause pollution, damage eco systems and cause odour and noise. It is an industrial development out of proportion to its setting. It will take productive land out of cultivation at a time when we need to increase

Our food security. Smaller farm based bio digesters could be considered to save traffic movement. Chicken manure as a fertiliser must now have a value in other parts of the UK with the costs of chemical fertilisers so expensive.
