Comment Dear Sir I am writing in support of this application and would ask the members who must decide this question to give particular attention to the jobs provided by this business. The people who work at the farm are frequently categorized as foreigners and somehow less worthy of concern. It is true that there are a large number of foreign born seasonal workers during the fruit season, but the farm also has a sizeable full time staff of both British and foreign born people all of whom have made a home in Herefordshire, many with children at local schools. I believe many people have been encouraged to object to this application out of concern for the value of their house. I am currently selling a house in Kings Caple (5 Caven) and my valuer confirmed to me that the Poly tunnels in the village had no impact on his valuation, also not one of the prospective purchasers has ever mentioned them. The house is currently under offer.
