Cider house. Probably C18. Sandstone rubble with tiled roof. Rectangular plan aligned east/west. Two storeys, one window, a 4-pane casement to each floor; two ledged doors one to right and one to left hand side, tallet stairs rise to third ledged door to left of centre. Interior contains press and mill; trusses have curved principals with collars supporting V-struts.

Stables. Probably C18. Timber-frame with plaster and brick infill, weather-boarded gables and tiled roof. Probably four bays aligned roughly north/south. Two levels. East elevation has three openings, a stable door between the left pair and a second entry to the right hand side. Frame is two panels high from cill to wall-plate and has angle struts from corner posts to wall-plate.

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
