I write with regards to the above application for retrospective planning and advertisement consent.

To update you on progress to date, I do not identify any significant policy conflicts and am therefore generally supportive of the proposal.

Notwithstanding this, we have received a number of representations from residents raising concerns over the additional litter generated as a result of receipts from the cash point being dropped. Being familiar with the site, I have seen this for myself on many occasions and can understand their concerns. As such, I feel it necessary to require that a litter bin be placed/mounted in an appropriate location next to the ATM. I would be happy to accept a scheme of waste bin provision (as well as details of how this will be managed, maintained and emptied) now, or alternatively can attach a condition to this end.
