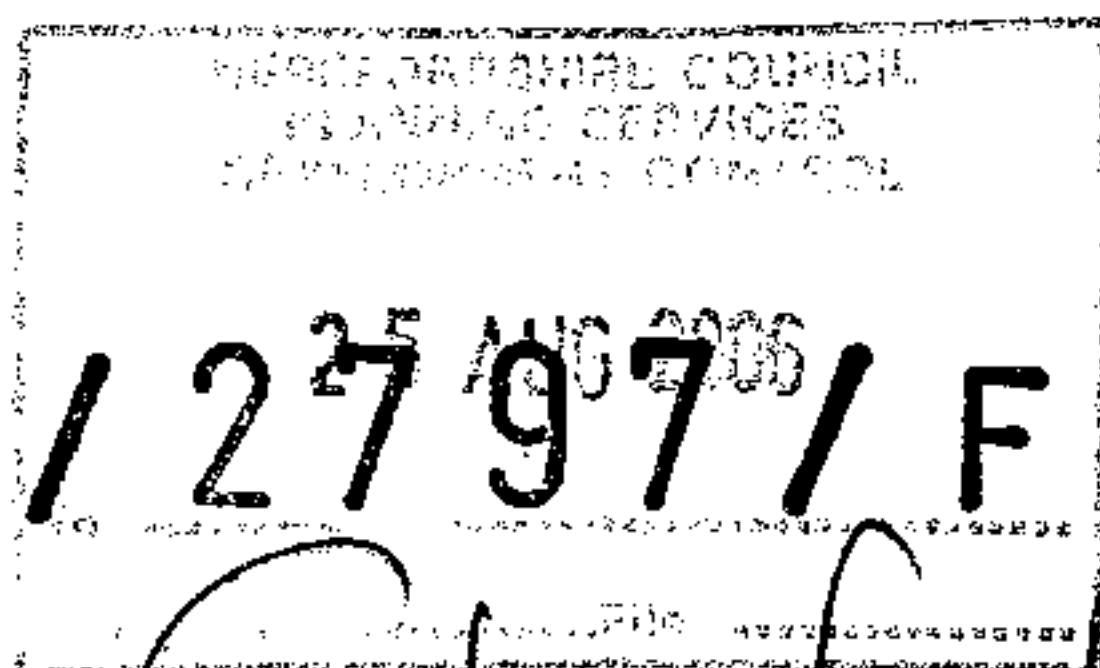

no material change, access is an
issue previously approved as was
landscaping and other minor issues.
In terms of the proposed my client
proposes as the drawings clearly indicate
that he intends to use materials as
previously approved on the form itself.
The extension is of modest proportions
is to replace a previous structure
and will be expected to satisfy the
medical needs of a Registered
Disabled Person.

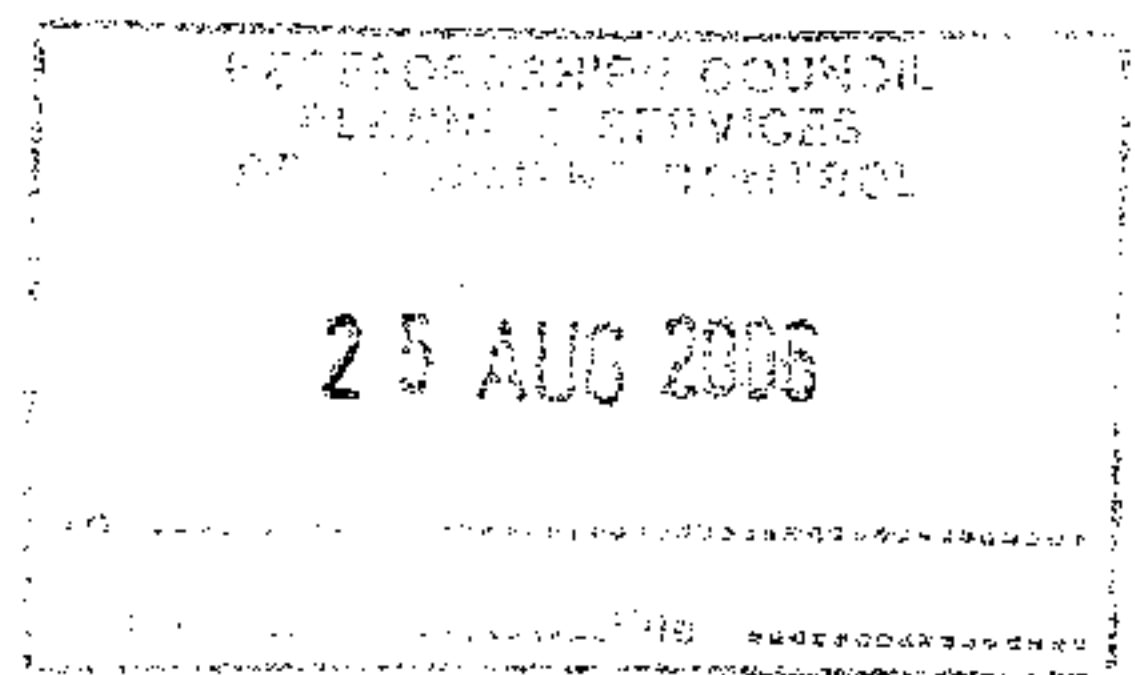
