Nature of feedback: Objecting to the application

Comment:

I have just witnessed (29.10.2020) a large HGV attempting to pull out from Weston Beggard Lane junction, turning right onto the A4103 road heading south towards Worcester. Because this junction is on an incline, the lorry had to do a hill start and was very slow getting away. There are two blind bends looking left and right from the Weston Beggard junction. Because the traffic is travelling so fast around these bends it is essential that you have a fast get away from the junction to avoid a traffic collision. The HGV this morning waited until it was clear but, because of the blind bend, its lack of speed and the fast approaching traffic, the north bound vehicles had to instigate emergency breaking measures to avoid a collision. The visibility and conditions were good this morning, however, Shucknall Spout is also located at this area and is notorious for over spilling onto the road and icing over in freezing conditions. Therefore, I object to this planning application as I understand that there will be an increase in HG Vehicles accessing this Weston Beggard Lane junction on and off the busy A4103 road.
