# Planning Consultation 212404

Llangarron Parish Council commented that this retrospective application to remove an agricultural tenancy condition should be reviewed by the LPA given its background. In particular, it is noted that the house was built in 1996 for this purpose but was never used by an agricultural tenant as it states 'situations changed'. The present owners who bought the property in don't seem to be involved in agriculture and whilst they may wish to regularize the situation to enable them to market the property it seems that a planning condition has been ignored since the house was built and there is a risk this may create a precedent?
