Councillors resolved to object to this application for the following reasons:-

- 1. There is no information on whether the proposed access is approved, as stated by the applicant.
- The proposed access would conflict with the proposed access to the Hardwick Bank strategic housing site, which would potentially jeopardise the strategic site, and is unacceptable in highway safety terms.
- 3. Concerned there is only one access to and from the site is proposed which raises issues in terms of access for emergency services.
- 4. Concerned at the sparsity of information accompanying the application e.g. there is no ecological survey, no landscape report, no contamination report etc.
