Particulars and location of development

Emergency stopping place for gypsies with resident warden's pitch and space for up to 20 caravans at the County Council Highways Salt Store, off Stone Street, Madley, near Hereford.

Part II - Particulars of decision

Hereford and Worcester County Council hereby give notice in pursuance of the provisions of the above Acts and Regulations that permission has been granted for the carrying out of the development referred to in Part I hereof in accordance with the application and plans submitted subject to the following conditions:-

1. The development must be begun not later than the expiration of five years beginning with the date of this permission.
2. This permission enures for the benefit of Hereford and Worcester County Council only.
3. The details and siting of the amenity block shall be submitted to and agreed in writing by the County Planning Authority before any work on the site commences.
4. A cesspit shall be provided for all the temporary sites users and emptied regularly.
5. The warden's septic tank and ancillary soakaway system must not be sited within 10 metres of any watercourse, must not affect any potable water source and shall be to the satisfaction of the National Rivers Authority.
6. Details of fencing shall be agreed with the County Planning Authority before work on site commences.
7. Details of the access and the visibility splays at the junction of the access with Stone Street [UC73203] shall be submitted and approved by the County Planning Authority before work on site commences.
