The following is a comment on application '**P171532/O**' by '**Matthew Bailey**'

**Nature of feedback:** Objecting to the application

**Comment:**

Whilst I have no objection in principle to the expansion of the town in this area - the idea that a development can be readily served by a single access from the Bromyard Road is nonsensical. Whilst the road is no doubt capable of actually having the additional traffic - the access underneath the railway bridge is a bottle neck which is regularly clogged up at peak times and is always a difficult turn right towards the by-pass and Hereford particularly as the route is used by lorries from the industrial estate. The roundabout which is currently already in situation on the bypass section and would lead under the viaduct is already suitable and 'designed' to take vehicular access onto the bypass and Hereford. There can be no benefit of making cars drive a further distance around from the Bromyard road to get to Hereford and beyond. If the viaduct is too narrow for a dual access or there are concerns of people using the estate as a rat run then could a one-way system not be put in place or restricted access at certain times? Thank you for your consideration of this matter.
