Please be aware that this property is understood to be served by a private potable water supply. Consideration should therefore be given to potential impacts of the proposal on the water quality and sufficiency of the supply and to ensure that the supply is sufficient to serve the proposal.

Applicants also need to be aware that providing holiday accommodation would change their water usage category from a single domestic to a Regulation 9 (commercial) property. Under the Private Water Supply (England) Regulations 2016, monitoring of Regulation 9 supplies must be carried out in accordance with schedule 2 to the Regulations and any additional monitoring that the risk assessment shows to be necessary. Risk Assessments will therefore need to be undertaken every 5 years in addition to annual sampling. Fees for this service will be charged to the responsible person at the rate set by the Local Authority.
