Nature of feedback: Submitting a general comment

Comment:

I am writing on behalf of the Ledbury Area Cycle Forum (LACF).

Herefordshire Council's Highway Design Guide requires that cycle parking be provided for all new residential developments, in the form of a covered, lockable shed or garage. The LACF further recommends that each residential unit has a level, easily accessed storage area that is big enough to store one bike per bed-space, and that it is provided with a power point so that it can be used for parking rechargeable electric cycles and mobility scooters, thereby reducing car-dependency.

While P200076 is not the creation of a new residential unit, the rear extension builds over the existing cycle storage space in the courtyard area, accessed from Bridge Street via the shared covered walkway. The proposed development should include the provision of a suitably sized level access cycle storage shed with a power supply for recharging E-bikes batteries.
