**Objection to planning application no. P173774/F – Proposed Erection of up to 32 hectares of fixed (non-rotated) 'Spanish Polytunnels' over arable (soft fruit) crops grown on 'table tops'; and associated application numbers P17377 5/F, P17377 6/F, P17377 7/F, P17377 8/F, P17377 9/F and P1737 80/F.**

I strongly object to the proposed development as detailed in the above planning applications.

I am concerned with the impact of the development on the busy A4137 road if this significant development gets the go-ahead.

This vast new industrial scale Poly tunnels development which is directly adjacent to the A4137, which is known to be a dangerous road (in the top 10 of dangerous roads in Britain). Creating a busy vehicular access onto this road, and allowing a potentially large number of pedestrians (workers) to walk along the road with no foot path will significantly increase risk and the likelihood of accidents.

The proposed Poly tunnels will create a distraction to motorists and cyclists because of the vast scale of this development. This development will come into view at bends that have limited visibility of oncoming vehicles, therefore creating a distraction to drivers, which is a road safety risk.

I strongly believe that if planning permission is granted for this development the immediate and potential future impact on the region could be significant.
