This application should not even be considered. A major part of the reason why the application for an Eastern bypass was thrown out in the late 1980s/early 1990s was the consequence of run off onto the Lugg Flats, an area of very Special Scientific Interest, both zoological and botanical, and this development would have a very similar effect. It is not in an area where any Local Development Plan has even considered building houses. The fact that there is now a farm road running at the bottom of the hill is immaterial. The amount of traffic on that road is, fortunately, minimal, and certainly much less than still travels on Eign Road and Hampton Park Road to Court Farm at Hampton Bishop.
