PLANNING OFFICER'S APPRAISAL:

Site description and proposal:

The application site comprises a Grade II listed building, within Hereford city centre. Built in 1927, as a bank premises, the three storey building of classical style has ashlar elevations with a parapet roof. It is within the primary shopping frontage, as defined in the HUDP, the Central Conservation Area and the Hereford Area of Archaeological Interest. There are two entrances into the building on the principal elevation.

Advertisement Consent for the displaying of illuminated fascia advertisements and nonilluminated signs, including a projecting hanging sign on the principal elevation (south) has already been granted (130255/A). An application for Listed Building Consent was not submitted concurrently, and hence this application made subsequently. The scheme essentially changes the company name from 'Lloyds TSB' to 'Lloyds Bank' and modifies the font and design. The 2 replacement fascia signs would sit within the existing fascias, centrally placed above two of the five ground floor windows, with internally illuminated lettering. The hanging sign would be sited where the existing sign is and would not be illuminated. The other signs would replace existing signs.

Constraints:

Grade II listed building, Conservation Area, Hereford Area of Archaeological Interest.

Appraisal:

The site comprises an important listed building within the historic core of the city centre. It is also within the Central Conservation Area. The building constitutes a heritage asset and therefore chapter 12 of the NPPF applies. Planning policies HBA1 and HBA6 are applicable and require that the components that make up the special importance of the building are protected and that proposals should preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the Conservation Area. The fascia signs proposed are individual letters centrally located above the second and fourth ground floor window. They are considered to be a 'light touch' approach. Given the size and design of the proposed advertisements, which would only moderately differ to the existing and the context of the site, together with the existence of illuminated signs on the host building and neighbouring units it is considered that the proposal would not have an adverse impact upon the importance of the fabric of the listed building and would preserve the character and appearance of the Conservation Area.

The City Council has no objections and the Ward Member is agreeable to a delegated decision.

Due to the type of application there would be no impact upon the AAI.

The proposal would accord with the requirements of the NPPF and relevant polices of the HUDP.
