

New Porch Canopy at Willow Cottage Back Lane Weobley Hereford HR4 8SG

Design and Access Statement

Introduction:

Willow Cottage is situated on Back Lane in the middle of Weobley village. It stands on a plot of approx 480 sq m.

The existing property comprises a traditional two bay black and white section parallel and adjacent to Back Lane, with a single storey 1950's addition set back from the road and at right angle to the original structure. On the garden side is a new addition completed in the past 18 months. The property has clay tiled roofs of various pitches and a flat roofed section in the centre linking the three elements.

The external walls have a mix of finishes, traditional timber framing, weatherboarding, and render. The pitched roofs are all tiled with clay tiles.

Design:

The existing porch is in need of a major overhaul. It is considered out of keeping with the rest of the property and rather than a straight forward replacement of what is there, the new porch will have a pitched tiled roof of a similar style to the other parts of the dwelling.

The roof will be supported with raked timber struts secured to the face of the external masonry walls.

Access:

The existing property is occupied by the owner and no additional accommodation is being created by the proposed works. No variation to the current access is required.
