Thank you for your email. Without the benefit of seeing any revised proposal there may be some scope for a modest reduction on this 8 metre restriction as long as there is no impact on flood storage or flood flows, which would need to be confirmed in any reserved matters application. However, we would not wish to see any permanent built development (dwellings) within this area, but may accept roads/footpath and/or fencing and with a minimum of 6 metres still maintained. Any works within 8 metres will also be subject to a Flood Risk Activity Permit (FRAP) from the Environment Agency.

I hope you are keeping well.

I write in respect of the above site in Peterchurch, Herefordshire, on which you provide the attached consultation comments. This resulted in Condition 15 being imposed on the permission;

15 There must be no new buildings, structures (including gates, walls, fences or any other means of enclosure) within 8 metres of the top of the bank of the River Dore (Main River).

Reason: To maintain access to the watercourse for maintenance or improvements and provide for overland flows.

For convenience, I attach a copy of your comments along with the indicative site layout that accompanied the application.

We now preparing a reserved matters application, but the 8m no build restriction is proving to be a significant constraint to achieving the level of development approved at outline stage. I therefore wondered whether there was any scope for negotiation on the 8m buffer, as long as we allow sufficient distance for maintenance of the river bank and as long as we ensure that overland flows are not restricted.

In the interest of openness, I have cc'd this to Simon Withers, Development Manager for the Area as the previous planning officer has since left the Authority.
