Nature of feedback: objecting_to_the_application

Comment:

Weston Beggard Parish Council wish to continue to OBJECT to the application for the following reasons:

- No efforts have been made to address the concerns listed in the original Parish Council objection.
- There is still not enough detail on aspects such as noise abatement
- The application is contrary to NDP Policy WB3. In particular it would not protect or enhance the character and tranquillity of the area; would not enhance residential amenity and does not possess a sustainable drainage system or flood storage measures.
- It is also contrary to NDP Policy WB4 (specifically 7.36) as it would not benefit the local economy in anyway.
- The issue of access on to the A4103 remains dangerous
- It is contrary to Herefordshire Council's eco-agenda
- It would exacerbate the issue of excess phosphates in the region.
