I strenuously object to the above planning proposal for a number of reasons, the chief objection being the increased traffic on Three Elms, Kings Acre and Roman Roads, all flowing towards the centre of town because of the lack of a ring road.

The traffic in Hereford is deemed to be slower/worse than London - another 1200 cars will put us over the top and bring us to a standstill. In addition, there is not sufficient infrastructure for the increased volume of people (schooling, medical, pharmaceutical) and the basic beauty of our city will be forever spoilt by smog, clog and moan.
