- . As straight as possible
- . Well lit
- . Devoid of potential hiding places
- . Overlooked by surrounding buildings
- . Well maintained so as to enable natural surveillance along the path and its border
- . It is important that the user has good visibility along the route of the footpath
- . The footpath should be as much "designed" as the buildings.

Holy Gutter Lane does not meet any of the above desired criteria.

This historical path cannot accommodate potentially another 850 pedestrians and cycles using it.
