**Nature of feedback: Objecting to the application**

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**Comment:** Planning Search : P241366/F

As a close neighbour adjacent to the Lamb Inn, I totally object to the proposed changes outlined in the planning application.

Since 2018, the flat roof has been used as a seating area, effectively acting as a theatre auditorium looking directly into neighbouring gardens. From 2023, a metal staircase was added, which is totally out-of-keeping with the village aesthetics. Furthermore, a metal balustrade was erected soon after, allowing further use of the "balcony." This has been extremely intrusive.

Growing trees and shrubs to a higher height has given me some privacy, but at a detrimental cost to my neighbours, as this restricts their afternoon sunlight.

On a final note, Stoke Prior is a well-regarded and friendly village, which needs a village community hub and focal point. We have no pub, no shop, no post-office, and an aging village hall.
