Comment: This pub was a very successful and important part of the village. It was always well supported and benefited from its riverside location and the neighbouring caravan site. It does flood but that could be managed as a pub far easier than if it was a house. To achieve use as a house it would need the ground floor raised above the 100 year flood level, attenuation would need to be provided and of course safe dry access. I believe policy precludes new housing in a flood plain unless in very special circumstances, I question if that applies in this case. It has an existing permission for a pub and given the right person I'm sure it could be a success and asset for the village again and its demise would be a sad loss
