Nature of feedback: Objecting to the application

Comment: I wish to strongly object to this planning application on the following grounds

1 it's detrimental effect to the local wildlife and nature. This is a SSSI site . There are only 14 Lammas meadows in the UK and the Lugg Meadows are one of them , they can be traced back to Dooms day and beyond. Hay was sold from these meadows to provide funds to rebuild Hereford Cathedral in the 11th / 12th century. As a council you would not dream of demolishing part of the Cathedral would you??.

2 There's a very good chance of pollution from this development getting into the Lugg when flooding occurs which is a regular occurrence. The runoff from driveways causing petroleum, Diesel and Oil to spill into a SSSI site .

3 This Development would come under Hampton Bishop Parish Council and The Hampton Bishop neighbourhood plan has already been met with a previous development already.

4 retention ponds have allocated but no precise depth or width mentioned , vertically impossible to hold back flood water and a possible risk to life if a primary school is built .

This development contravenes Hereford Council policies SS6, LD1, LD4 (NC1, NC3, NC4 NC6) and therefore should be refused.
