## Construction of a 6,000 bird "free range" egg production unit.

Whilst this proposed development is situated to the east of the principal farm buildings (ie away from the most significant heritage assets such as the motte and the church), it is nevertheless in an location of some sensitivity with recorded medieval settlement remains and recorded earthworks in the vicinity. Although I have no objections to the development, I would advise a suitable archaeological condition, such as standard condition E01.

This is likely to lead to a 'watching brief' type of archaeological project in the field.
