I would like to raise my objections to the above Planning Application.

I am extremely concerned that if this Application is passed it will add immeasurably to the volume of traffic through the village. There is already a serious problem with both the volume and the speed of traffic passing through Lyonshall and this development will only make matters much worse.

Also, the existing drainage and sewage system can barely cope as it is. With extra housing being planned this will put an enormous strain on the drainage system. We have had instances in the past where our driveway has been flooded with both water and raw sewage. What guarantees can be given that this will not become a regular occurrence if this development is allowed to go ahead?

Also, this development will, I think, completely spoil the natural environment.

There seems to be an alarming number of planning applications for Lyonshall and I wonder whether sufficient thought has been given as to how this will affect the residents who already reside here and to how it will affect their quality of life.
