Nature of feedback: objecting_to_the_application

Comment:

I would like to object to the demolition of this historic Victorian building. Admittedly the building has fallen into disrepair but the structure is very solid and could be restored to provide accommodation and ideally some retirement flats or even supported living accommodation which is desperately needed. There are no other buildings in our village from this era and to demolish it and replace it with a concrete yard would be such a loss to the village's history. Other similar buildings in the area have been very successfully converted, one example being the old school in Norton, near Skenfrith. My other concern is there is no reference in the application of how the area will be decontaminated following its use for garaging and repairing agricultural machinery.
