Location: Land to the east side of Hereford south of Ledbury Road (A438). Hereford.

I have lived in Tupsley, Hereford for years. Whilst I understand the need for additional affordable housing I object to this planning application.

The application to build 350 houses on the land is ill advised and dangerous. To expect the roads in the area to absorb a potential 700 cars, especially at school times is unrealistic. The local schools are already at capacity and the promise of land to build another school is just a sop as there is no money available to build it.

The infrastructure in Hereford, Doctors Surgeries, Dentists, Hospitals are not able to cope already.

The water table is already extremely high in the area and there will be difficulty with drainage and sewage once the use of so much impermeable material takes more of the natural landscape.

Though the proposed area of development does not often flood, it is where the wildlife that dwells on the floodplain escapes to. This will make for uneasy living conditions for the prospective residents.
