<u>Use</u>

To cover an existing concrete yard that is used to sort and handle cattle. The purpose of the roof is to prevent the diffuse pollution that occurs when this operation takes place during inclement weather.

<u>Amount</u> SW09/0207/F

The building will cover an area of 243 metres square (10.9 x 22.3).

Layout

The proposed building will adjoin the east end of an existing livestock building.

<u>Scale</u>

The building will be 22.3m wide, 10.9 m deep, a ridge height of 8.4m to match the existing building and an eaves height of 4.9m on the north side and 6m on the south.

Landscaping

No additional landscaping will be required as the building will be situated between the building it will adjoin and the tree covered earth bund that surrounds that.

Access

Access points to the existing concrete yard will be used.
