# **PLANNING OFFICER'S APPRAISAL:**

# Site description and proposal:

Brockhampon Primary Academy lies in an elevated position adjacent to the unclassified road 65021, several hundreds of metres from the A44. The detached building is surrounded to the

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north and east by woodland, owned by the National Trust. To the south of the site and across the road is open countryside looking toward Bromyard.

This application relates to the proposal to remove a temporary detached classroom unit situated to the north of the school building with an extension to the school to the rear elevation of the building on its western corner. The extension measures: 9.4m (L)  $\times$  6.1m (W)  $\times$  5.8m (H) with windows to the northwest and northeast elevations and a window and door to the southwest and southeast elevations. The extension will be accessed from the existing school building from the southwest elevation. The proposed extension will be finished in cast reconstituted stone to match the existing quoined with brickwork to match existing and reconstituted stone lintels and cills. The pitched roof will be covered in small plain tiles to match the existing. Fenestration will differ from the existing with colour coated metal frames and double glazing.

### Appraisal:

The proposal for an extension to Brockhampton Primary Academy, Bringsty is assessed against relevant national and local planning policy contained in the National Planning Policy Framework and the Herefordshire Core Strategy.

The proposed building which is attached to the existing school at its southwest elevation demonstrate good design, established under Policy SD1. It is considered to be of a scale, size and type which is sympathetic to its surroundings and reflects local distinctiveness in terms of the surrounding landscape and the building to which it will be attached, LD1, LD2. Furthermore, the proposal is unlikely to impact detrimentally on the residential amenity of existing or future occupiers. Indeed, the proposal will enhance existing educational infrastructure, improving facilities through the provision of a new educational environment. Policy SC1 of the Herefordshire Core Strategy provides that these types of proposals should be actively supported.

The proposal is sympathetically designed and is considered to be of benefit and enhancement to educational facilities at the school and adheres to sustainability policy contained in SS1. The proposal reflects the surroundings and will be a valuable additional facility to support education.
