Nature of feedback: Objecting to the application

Comment: The site borders the Lugg Meadows nature reserve, a site of special scientific interest and ecologically important flood plain.

I support Hereford wildlife objection and their list of environmental concerns and protection of wildlife breeding, especially for threatened species .

In addition I have seen the impact in other areas where flood plain is impacted with housing developments, flood water is displaced and the result is increased flooding in areas which have not flooded previously.

Hereford does not have the correct road or transport infrastructure to support additional housing in this location and it will negatively impact the surrounding area and wildlife further and increase air pollution.

I do not support this application based on these concerns. There are plenty of brownfield sites that should be first considered as priority.
