The scheme proposes a number of different surfaces within the external environment to allow access to all areas of the garden. The character of the areas varies across the site; this is reflected by the surfacing and the structures proposed. The following materials reflect the desired character for each area although are dependent on Architects approval and can be substituted for similar approved items.

surface - Ulticolour coloured asphalt. Buff
edge - Tobermore Kerbstone. Bracken

Stretcher bond. 208 x 173 x 50mm
edge - Tobermore Kerbstone. Bracken

Timber trellis to be built by contractor on site subject to Architect's approval.

Stone with drilled hole to feed water over surrounding pebble bed and into concealed storage pond beneath. No standing water. Power source required. Subject to Architect's approval.

Simple timber bench with arm rest and back to be located on a raft of asphalt to match the adjacent pathway surface and edging.
