**Nature of feedback:** Objecting to the application

**Comment:**

I am writing on behalf of Ledbury Area Cycle Forum (LACF).  
Herefordshire Council's Highway Design Guide requires that cycle parking be provided for all new residential developments, in the form of a covered, lockable shed or garage.

The LACF further recommends that the level-access storage area is big enough to store one bike per bed-space, and that it is provided with a power point so that it can be used for parking rechargeable electric cycles and mobility scooters, thereby reducing car-dependency for the short distance to Ledbury.

P180177/F has no provision for cycle storage and therefore does not meet Herefordshire Council's Highway Design Guide requirements and LACF recommendations.
