Comment:

There is no justification for allowing further housing growth because approval would lead to the promotion of unsustainable patterns of development.

There are already ten new dwellings under construction in Hatfield (7 barn conversions and 3 new homes)

The road through Hatfield is, in many places, single track with passing places. More traffic from further housing would be dangerous, inconvenient and disturbing to existing dwellings in the hamlet.

The proposed development is adjacent to a woodland habitat with pools specifically constructed for the encouragement and support of a diversity of wildlife and enhancement of the environment.

The proposed development would be to the detriment of this important area. The design of the proposed semi-detached houses is not in keeping with the other dwellings in the area because Hatfield houses are detached with gardens around them. I therefore object to the proposed application.
