Bodenham Parish Council considers that the changes and further information now provided about surface water drainage from the site of the proposed development are an improvement, but the Parish Council retains serious concerns about the disposal of sewage and is unconvinced by the further information in the application about sewage disposal. The Parish Council wishes to draw your attention to the detailed concerns it expressed about sewage disposal in its earlier response.

The existing Bodenham Moor sewage system is overloaded, yet it would appear that Welsh Water are seeking to direct any potential foul water from the other proposed development in the village (on the land south of Chapel Lane (P150437/F)) into this same northern part of the system. As has been pointed out repeatedly by the Parish Council and by many individual residents, the amenity of local residents is already badly affected and it is imperative that the village's system is upgraded before approval is given to any large new developments such as this.

Bodenham Parish Council considers any development prior to improvements in the sewage disposal system being undertaken to be premature and, therefore, <u>objects</u> to this application.
