Comment:

I wholeheartedly object to this proposal. Destroying this top grade agricultural land at Three Elms goes against the council's own vision for the future. Brexit means that we need to ensure, more than ever, that we can grow more of our own food locally, and climate change means that our farmers need more support not less. Brownfield sites would be more suitable. Huntington is an area of natural beauty that many people in the county enjoy - it supports people's mental health. This housing would damage the natural environment forever. This site will never be the right one for these homes. Moreover, we need net zero/ zero carbon homes but these homes will not meet these requirements.
