**Nature of feedback: Objecting to the application**

---

**Comment:** Major concerns as to how this application will affect wildlife. Regularly see nesting birds such as curlews on this site. Issues currently with pollution from the build and run off into adjacent rivers. The site is a designated flood plan and is currently under water. The area is also a legally protected area of Special 'scientific interest with a fragile eco system and nationally scarce plant species including Narrow leafed Water-dropwort. It is also one of the few ancient Lammas floodplain meadows in England adjacent to the River Lugg and adjacent to the already polluted River Wye which is currently being championed by Anthea McIntyre MP with a current £35 m campaign to clean it up. The River Wye is classified as a Site of Special Scientific interest and is home to protected species such as otters, kingfishers, white clawed crayfish and the Atlantic salmon.
