Site description and proposal:

6 Parsons Walk, Pembridge, Leominster, Herefordshire, HR6 9EP

G1 - Two group's of Leylandi species - Proposed works to reduce height by approx.4ft down to previous cuts and trims sides still allowing adequate privacy to neighbouring properties.

T1 - Silver Birch - Fell due to lifting root plate.

<u>Representations</u>: Pembridge PC met and were happy for this work to be done.

<u>Pre-application discussion</u>: None.

<u>Constraints</u>: Conservation area.

Appraisal:

The proposed works are regarded as appropriate arboreal undertakings that are hoped will not have a lasting impact on the public amenity value of the local area or negatively affect the quality of the conservation area.

It is considered that a preservation order is not necessary to prevent the works proceeding. Accordingly it is recommended that the proposed works should be permitted.
