Regarding the above two appeals, from my understanding of the process, my letter of objection will have been forwarded on for your perusal.

For the avoidance of doubt, I confirm that my views remain the same with regard to my objection.

My property, where I live with my wife, is just below the Wynne's and as such they are our neighbours to the north of our property. There is nothing personal regarding my objection. I have serious concern about any increase in traffic on the narrow lane which runs up from the village to Wynne's. Having turned left after the railway bridge to travel up to the site, the lane is single track and there have always been incidents and difficulties using it.

There has been a noticeable increase in traffic since the Wynne's opened their shop, animal viewing & sales, plus the cafe. A nursery and unspecified businesses will increase traffic flow to a level of very high risk of more accidents and incidents.

Concern centres on young children being driven up and down the lane on a regular basis. The lane may look pleasantly rural but having blind bends and being single track, it is dangerous and makes it unsuitable for developments at Wynne's which will increase traffic.
