There has been some confusion in relation to air quality and the need for an assessment. My colleague Philippa Hargraves has been in discussion with a consultant, which I believe is working for you in relation to producing an air quality assessment. I have not received any formal comments from Philippa yet in connection with this application, although it was believed the assessment which to be carried out was in connection with this application. However following reascent conversations it is now believed that the assessment being undertaken is in connection with the previous outline permission and condition 9 not this current application. Could you clarify the position for me? Philippa has indicated that she will be requiring an assessment prior to determination of this current application and I have asked her to provide further comments as soon as she can I can forward these to you.

I would also like to take ask for you to agree to an extension of time for the application. Given that we are approaching the holiday season and the anticipated need for the air quality assessment I would suggest the 1st September 2018. This should give us sufficient time. The local member for the area has agreed that the application can be dealt with under delegated powers and will not need to go in front of a planning committee.
