I am writing this letter in support of the above planning application for two chicken houses.

Mr. R. Demars in his letter of opposition mentions environmental pollution affecting the quality of life of residents and visitors.

The new poultry sheds proposed will be insulated, made of the same material as the existing farm buildings.

All water from the site will be collected in sealed tanks very tightly regulated by the Environmental agency in the form of an IPPC permit.

The new style of roof mounted fans, circulate fresh air into the sheds, and do not disturb the bedding and feed, like the older type of side fans, any particles which do make their way outside, will only be of organic material.

As a born and bred Monklander, I cannot see how two modern poultry sheds could possibly affect either Leominster's residents and visitors or Monklands.

I worked on a poultry farm for 30 years, so know what I am talking about.

I also wish it noted that, I feel very cross that Monkland Parish Council in its letter to the Council is telling residents to oppose this planning application, as we all have brains and are quite capable of making our own decisions.
