



PLANTING NOTES

Generally

Where appropriate all relevant British Standards shall apply.

Vegetation Protection:

To protect existing trees during construction works, 2 meter high fencing shall be erected around the protected trees. The fence shall be installed at the commencement of the works and maintained in-situ until the works are complete. The fencing shall be erected to alignments at the full canopy extent and shall be agreed on site with the architect prior to commencement.

Topsoil Operations

Topsoil shall be stripped to its full depth from all areas which are to be developed. It shall be kept, weed free, in stockpiles on site for future use. Subsoils shall be thoroughly cultivated before topsoil application. All areas of compacted ground shall be ripped. All beds of ornamental shrubs and ground covers shall be topsoiled to a depth of 300mm

Plants and Planting

Specimen Trees

Specimen Trees shall comprise Advanced Nursery Stock and Multi stem trees. They shall be planted in topsoiled pits to a min size 900mm X 750mm deep and double staked

Ornamental Shrubs and Ground Covers

All ornamental Shrubs and Ground Cover species shall be planted from minimum 3 litre pots into beds topsoiled to a minimum depth of 300mm.

As a guide:

- Low ground covers shall be planted at 4-5 plants per m²

- Medium to taller shrubs shall be planted at 1-3 plants per m²

Mulching

All new plantings shall be mulched with either mushroom compost, green waste or composted bark

Establishment Maintenance

All planting works shall be subject to a 5 year Maintenance Programme, including replacement of failed plants on an annual basis. Operations shall include:

- Weeding
- Watering
- Pruning / Coppicing / Pollarding
- Top dressing with fertiliser
- Topping up Mulch
- Replacing / securing guards and stakes

Remedial works to existing mature or established trees in accordance with notes.

No works to trees and hedgerows shall be undertaken during the bird nesting season

SPECIMEN BROADLEAVED TREES

Individual Advanced Nursery Stock to include: *Betula jacquemontii*, *Crataegus oxyacantha*, *Juglans nigra*, *Rubus fruticosa*, *Sorbus aria* *Dacotense*, *Sorbus aucuparia* *Commissa*.

SPECIMEN EVERGREEN / CONIFEROUS TREES

Individual Advanced Nursery Stock to include: *Ilex aquifolium* J.C. Van Tol, *Laurus nobilis*, *Magnolia grandiflora*, *Pinus nigra*.

SHRUB PLANTING

Taller screen shrub planting species to include: *Buddleia alternifolia*, *Choisya ternata*, *Elaeagnus pungens* *Maculata Variegata*, *Philadelphus Virginal*, *Photinia fraseri* Red Robin, *Prunus* *Garret Rose*, *The Fairy*, *Rosmarinus officinalis* Steven Blass, *Rubus* *fulgidus* Goldsturm, *Silva officinalis* Purpurea, *Spiraea Snowmound*, *Symphoricarpos* *Chenaultii* Hancock, *Viburnum davidii*.

GROUNDCOVER SHRUBS AND PERENNIALS

Low growing shrub and herbaceous groundcover planting species to include: *Achillea Gold Plate*, *Bergenia cordifolia*, *Ceanothus thyrsiflorus Repens*, *Erica carnea*, *Echinacea purpurea* Magnus, *Euonymus fortunei* Silver Queen, *Geranium Ann Folkard*, *Hebe rakaensis*, *Heuchera Palace Purple*, *Pentstemon Garnet*, *Rosa The Fairy*, *Rosmarinus officinalis* Steven Blass, *Rubus* *fulgidus* Goldsturm, *Silva officinalis* Purpurea, *Spiraea Snowmound*, *Symphoricarpos* *Chenaultii* Hancock, *Viburnum davidii*.

GRASSY TYPE PLANTS

Species to include: *Acorus calamus*, *Allium affluens*, *Carex pendula*, *Crocus* *Minimus* Lucifer, *Cortaderia selloana* Pumila, *Pinus mugo* Pumilo, *Rosmarinus officinalis*, *Spiraea* gigantea,

FEATURE PLANTS

Species to include: *Ficus carica*, *Fatsia japonica*, *Kniphofia* Bees Sunset, *Magnolia stellata*, *Hydrangea quercifolia*, *Mahonia Winter Sun*, *Phomium tenax* Purpureum.

CLIMBING PLANTS

Species to include: *Hedera colchica* Dentata Variegata, *Hydrangea petiolaris*, *Lonicera* *japonica* Halliana, *Pyracantha watereri*.

FORMAL HEDGING

Formal clipped evergreen hedging species to include: *Prunus lusitanica*, *Taxus baccata* planted in double staggered rows at 300mm centres.

TRAILING PLANTS

Species to include: *Ceanothus thyrsiflorus* Repens, *Euonymus fortunei* Silver Queen, *Vinca minor*

MOWN GRASS

Area of closely mown lawn

GRASS CRETE

Area of grass crete or similar & approved
