## Feedback: Objecting to Planning Application P232851/F and Recent Amendments Posted 07/02/2024

Dear Sir/Madam

Further to the recent amendments posted on the planning portal 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024. I note the very small reduction in area of the family room, c4% of the total scheme area. However, I continue to object to the planning application P232851/F as the reasons for my objections have not been addressed.

Please refer also to my previous objections: '20231108-3 Aubreys Objection overall' and '20240105-2 Aubreys Objection Drainage', 20240510-4 Aubreys Objection Policies, and 20240510-1 Aubreys 3 Objection, all of which remain relevant because the application fails to meet so many of the policy requirements. To summarise:

- There is no valid drainage strategy primarily because the package treatment plant discharges into a dry seasonal watercourse.
- Scheme fails SD4 Waste water treatment and river water quality
- Drainage strategy fails to comply with General Binding Rule 17
- Drainage strategy fails to comply with General Binding Rule 19
- Drainage strategy breaches Riparian Rights under Common Law.
- The scheme fails to comply with the criteria of; E3, RA3, RA5, RA6, LD1, LD2, LD3, LD4, SD1, SD2, SD3, SD4, LGPC4
- Does not address the concerns raised by the Historic Buildings Officer.
