Hello Michael.

Good to hear from you.

I am fine with the report being used by the existing landowner for the new application.

The basic nature of the site is unlikely to have changed in the intervening 3 years though care should be exercised with species such as badger which can colonise sites within this time period and the applicant should be able to satisfy the LPA that there are no badger setts on site or within 30m. From recollection in this case the land form is such that it should be possible fairly easily.

We generally don't issue reliance letters as we are advised by our Chartered institute these are inappropriate for ecological reports. As ecologists we hold both PI and PL insurance.

Hopefully this will be helpful.

Dear Mr Smith,

I have considered your request and established that whilst a little unusual, there is some precedent for utilising reports from older applications. However, this will depend entirely on producing confirmation that the author of the report is happy with that and of course on determining its relevance to the current application.

I see that this particular matter relates to an Ecology Report dated February 2014. It is usually the case that such a report is valid for around 2 years from completion and as such this does shed significant doubt upon the efficacy of relying on this document to consider the biodiversity value of the site.

I would suggest that you consider the following:

- (a) Secure agreement of the author of the original Ecology Report
- (b) Establish with our Ecologist whether this provides sufficient information to assess the value of the current application site

# Failing that

(c) Commission a report to support the current application.

I hope that this is of assistance.
