PLANNING OFFICER'S APPRAISAL:

Site description and proposal:

The site is located at the village of Llangrove. Previous planning permission has been given for the destruction of the existing building on site and the construction of a new dwelling. The new development has not yet been completed, but construction is underway.

The proposal is for a variation of condition on permission P131997/F. Specifically, the applicant wishes to change the accepted guttering system to a black upvc system.

Appraisal:

Policy context and Principle of Development

Section 38 (6) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 states as follows: *"If regard is to be had to the development plan for the purpose of any determination to be made under the Planning Acts the determination must be made in accordance with the plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise."*

In this instance the adopted development plan is the Herefordshire Local Plan – Core Strategy (CS). It is also noted that the site falls within the Llangarron Neighbourhood Area, which published a draft Neighbourhood Development Plan for Regulation 14 consultation on 6th February 2017. At this time the policies in the draft NDP can be afforded limited weight as set out in paragraph 48 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2018, which itself is a significant material consideration.

Overall the change of exterior water drainage design to black upvc is not considered to be significant. When visiting the site it was noted that a number of properties in the surrounding area have black upvc drainpipes, and therefore the change is considered to integrate well with the existing built environment in accordance with CS policy LD1. Therefore this change is considered acceptable and the application is considered for approval.
