(a) Matt Tompkins: Advice in letter dated 26/09/2012

- Swimming pool proposals accepted without modification.
- Garage accepted with comments on possible modifications to roof and clock tower.
- Proposed window modifications and staircase removal not supported.

(b) Sarah Lowe: Meeting on 19/10/2012 at Lower House

It was discussed and agreed that:

- A proposed amendment for the Garage roof form to full hips, rather than the earlier half hips, would be accepted. A clock tower would be accepted as timber construction.
- Windows to the house to be retained and refurbished with weather and draught sealing and possible internal secondary glazing, to improve thermal performance, subject to viability/practicalities of installing a suitable secondary glazing system.
- The secondary staircase would remain in place. It was accepted that a section of floor can be inserted above the stair to create a useable room on the first floor in place of the present landing/corridor space. The retained stair is to be enclosed on the ground floor, forming a kitchen cupboard with the treads as shelves.
