Nature of feedback: objecting to the application

Comment:

I am writing on behalf of Ledbury Area Cycle Forum (LACF) to object to the application as the proposals fail to make any provision for secure cycle storage. Cycle usage, especially by tourists visiting the area has increased significantly in recent years, as highlighted during recent lockdowns. The development is situated very close to the popular Ledbury Cider Cycling Route that helps to support local businesses (places of interest and refreshment opportunities) and encourage sustainable tourism. E-bikes are gaining in popularity and owners bringing them to holiday locations will require secure cycle storage in view of their high value. The encouragement of green tourism is key to the Council's revised countywide carbon dioxide reduction strategy adopted under its Climate Emergency Policy and should be an important consideration when determining planning applications.
