Staunton-on-Wye War Memorial Working Party has applied to the Secretary of State for Environment for consent under Section 38 of the Commons Act 2006, to carry out restricted works on **Doctors Pool**. The Planning Inspectorate will decide the application on behalf of the Secretary of State.

Proposed works are:

To relocate the War Memorial from the corner of the A438 and U90401, a dangerous and an unsuitable location for the memorial and visitors, to the Doctors Pool, common land at the junction of C1090 and U90404, HR4 7LT, Staunton-on-Wye, Herefordshire.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the A40 Trunk Road between Ross-on-Wye and the England/ Wales border in the County of Herefordshire, to enable verge repair works to be carried out. The effect of the Order, will be to, at different

- (1) impose a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A40 between a point 460 metres northeast of the centreline of Talybont Lane overbridge near Ganarew and the England/Wales border;
- - (a) the westbound carriageway of the A40 from its junction with the B4164 at Whitchurch to the England/Wales border; and
- (b) the eastbound carriageway of the A40 from the England/Wales border, to its junction with the unnamed road at Ganarew, 1500 metres northeast of that border:
- (3) close the eastbound carriageway of the A40 from the England/Wales border, to a point 865 metres northeast of that border and allow traffic to use lane two of the westbound carriageway in a contraflow
- prohibit any vehicle with an overall width prohibit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 2.9 metres from entering or proceeding on the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A40 between its roundabout junction with the A449, Ledbury Road and Netherton Road at Rosson-Wye, and the England/Wales border
- prohibit any vehicle from overtaking a moving vehicle on the westbound carriageway of the A40 from a point 865 metres northeast of the England/Wales border, to that border, when contraflow is in operation:

The work will be carried out overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 30 September 2024 and continue for approximately three months. The continue for approximately three months. Ine speed restriction, contraflow, and prohibitions will be in operation from 14:00 hours on Monday 30 September 2024 for 24 hours per day, for the duration of works. The order will come into force on Monday 23 September 2024 and have a maximum duration of 18 months.

Any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions and closures. Special forces vehicles will be exempt from the speed restrictions and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures Diversion routes via the A40/A465/A49 for

non-motorway traffic and via the A449, the M4 the M5, the A40 and vice versa will be signed. During the contraflow phase abnormal/wide loads exceeding 2.9 metres will be directed to use the A449/M4/M5/A40 diversion. For further enquiries please contact
