

I refer to the response from Environmental Health regarding the above application. The EHO requested the storage locations for poultry manure.


All manure will be removed following cleanout and transported off site for storage in field heaps prior to spreading. In order to comply with the NVZ regulations, these heaps must be rotated and you cannot store manure in the same place for consecutive years. The applicant has provided plans attached showing potential locations for field storage. All locations are more than 400m from protected dwellings, and comply with the NVZ regs regarding distances from watercourses etc.




MAIZE / FODDER BEET GROUND
