The following is a comment on application **P223221/F** by **Annie Humphreys**

Nature of feedback: Submitting a general comment

Comment: I have been advised by the farmers that use the fields that are on the boundary three sides of the orchard to draw your attention to the following.

The fields have been used by many generations for both arable and pasture farming and as such the following takes place.

It is standard practice to carry out activities on the fields during unsociable hours in the week and a weekend, especially at harvest time et;(which my calls noise concern to new residence)

The fields are also treated with the appropriate fertiliser as and when required by good farming practice which is an ongoing process and has been for many years.

Please take the above into account when considering the application. Also, I'd like to draw your attention to what we believe is a borehole on the boundary line (hedge) to the rear field. We can see no mention of this in the submission and would raise concern about the possible cross contamination caused by standard farming activities, but we're sure this will be looked into as standard practice.
