Discussion

· Barbara Fisher opened meeting in explaining Julie Joseph had stepped down from the Steering Group but was more than happy to give advice as and when wanted. Barbara proposed and Jenny Bailey seconded that David Chivers be appointed Chairperson. David agreed to take over.

Minutes of last meeting signed off.

 Barbara explained that she, together with Jenny and Julie Joseph had met with Data Orchard who had agreed to take over from Julie to finalise the Plan. Julie Joseph was in the process of making the amendments to the plan as agreed previously and would then forward to Data Orchard.

- 1 Already granted approval on land adjacent to The Butts.
- · Langstone Court buildings As Hfds. Council had queried this site agreed that the Neighbourhood plan would allude to this site rather than identify site.
- Herberts Hill agreed potential for 3 or 4 houses.
- Farr land noted that owners had attended recent Parish Council Meeting and were suggesting 8 houses on the plot. Agreed no more than 8 and that the area suggested for this site in draft Plan be reduced not to include existing barn.
- Agreed to discount the suggestion at previous meeting of land opposite Llangarron Village Hall.
